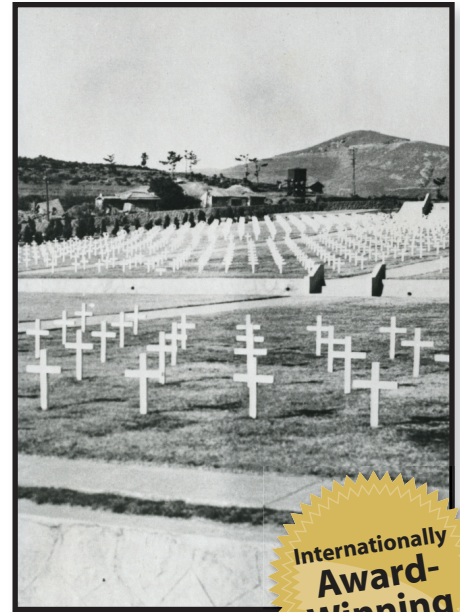


# NEVER AGAIN!

The theme song, written especially for the *Military Heritage Documentary Series*, was produced by Robin Moir and Joseph Turner, two Canadian musicians who have an outstanding reputation in the music industry. The song's memorable lyrics and beautiful melody have earned it several international awards.
